



CLASSROOM ACTIVITY 1

HOGWARTS NEARBY: PRONUNCIATION ESCAPE ROOM

OBJECTIVES

Pay attention to the pronunciation of vowels and consonants.

TIME REQUIRED

10 minutes.

NUMBER OF PEOPLE

In groups.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

Paper, pen and computer.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. The students are divided into groups of 3 and go through 5 rooms or 5 spaces in two rooms where there will be a computer with this link: <https://forms.gle/L6tZNYnpXWpNvZC48>. The teacher will be waiting in the last room.
2. In each of the rooms or spaces students will have to answer questions relating to the 5 "classes" of the escape room: Botany, Spells, History of Magic, Astronomy, and Transfiguration. Each room will have a score that is detailed in the final test.
3. In the Transfiguration class, (in which we will change the meaning of a sequence by changing a sound; for example: we transfigure "els ous" and "els sous"), the teacher will record the students and evaluate their pronunciation of the proposed sequences. This will add points to the score of the other rooms.
4. The winners of the escape room will be determined by which group has the most points and finishes all the tasks first.

SELF-EVALUATION AND REFLECTION GUIDE

The teacher will evaluate the successes of the escape room form as well as the pronunciation and improvement in perception and pronunciation of the words in the Transfiguration class.

If you want to continue practicing, the teacher can set homework to review the audios on the Catalan Pronunciation Guides website and ask students to make proposals for new escape rooms.
