



CLASSROOM ACTIVITY 1

READ WITH MEANING AND EXPRESSIVENESS

OBJECTIVES

Be able to read a story expressively, using the different qualities of the voice, with dynamic intonation, moderate rhythm and pauses.

TIME REQUIRED

30 minutes: 10 minutes to prepare and rehearse the story, 5 minutes to read it and 15 minutes to listen to and correct it.

NUMBER OF PEOPLE

Groups of 5 people.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

An audio-recording device.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. The text is divided into different parts, one for each member.
2. Practice reading the text aloud. Each person reads their part, making sense of what they are saying. The rest of the group helps them to make it sound expressive.
3. The story is recorded.
4. Finally, listen to the audio to correct the reading.

SELF-EVALUATION AND REFLECTION GUIDE

The evaluation will be based on listening to and correcting each group member's reading. Important points to consider:

- The speaker appropriately used high volume or intensity.
- There are tone changes and, therefore, the reading has not been monotonous.
- The pronunciation is correct and clear, even of difficult articulations.

-The reading is neither too slow nor too fast.

-The speaker made use of pauses.
